Father Daniel Mahan

Through the events of the parish mission, Father Mahan seeks to provide the participants with the opportunity:

- to deepen the bonds of communion in the Catholic Church; and
- to be more committed to the work that the Lord has given us to do

In addition, Father explores the critical themes of conversion and reconciliation, repentance, commitment, and mission, challenging his listeners to make each element a part of their lives.

Schedule

On Saturday, March 6 and Sunday, March 7, Father Mahan will preach the homily at all weekend Masses

On Sunday evening, the mission talk / homily will **focus on gratitude to God for all of the blessings we have received.** The evening will conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

Father Mahan will also offer a one hour presentation **on Monday, March 8 and Tuesday March 9 evenings.** The presentation will include a mission talk interspersed with prayer and song.

On Monday evening, the mission talk will **focus on responsibility in the care of God’s gifts.** The evening will conclude with the opportunity for the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.

On Tuesday evening, the mission talk will **focus on the generous sharing of God’s gifts with others and making a return to the Lord with increase.** The evening will conclude with an opportunity for those attending to come forward for an individual blessing. Father suggests that a parish social be held on Sunday evening or on Tuesday evening, following the evening events.
